Looking back, 2017 has been another exciting year for us. We are just so amazed and blessed by the progression we see year after year in each orphanage we are involved in. We have taken some huge steps of faith and each step has proven to be a great success. We anticipate a great 2018! Thank you for partnering with us. We have been able to accomplish so much in 2017 and believe we will see greater accomplishments this year. The best is yet to come!

Nairobi, Kenya

Our annual trip to Kenya is exciting. Grace Care Home is bursting at the seams! Some of the young people are now grown up and going on to university. We have been privileged to give assistance through our child sponsorship fund. The home is gaining great notoriety through musicals, dramas and their national exams. They are winning national awards. Consider supporting an orphan! **Sponsorships for this orphanage are \$30/month.**

We are also involved with the Lighthouse Academy, located in another slum in Nairobi. 180 slum children are educated by Bible Truth Revival Church. This church provides K-12 education with qualified teachers. The children are fed one meal per day and receive school uniforms.

Through new technology, we are able to provide some tablets which provides updated education each year. The cost is \$7000.00 USD for 40 tablets which includes a solar operated recharger. With grade 12 education, the children can go on to secondary education and will not return to the slums.

Cebu, Philippines

This year two of our directors travelled to Cebu, Philippines. They were able to see the advancements of the Cure Foundation. The fifth home is completed and more little girls will be saved from sex trafficking. The village in the mountains of Cebu is bursting with activity. Little children as young as 2 years old are taught and cared for by wonderful house parents. Presently they house over 30 children in the 4 cottages. The village was fenced this year, bringing more security. They continue to build more homes so more children can be saved. We will take a team to Cebu in the Fall of 2018.

Sanya, China

We visited the Bright Connection. This home is for physically and mentally disabled children. Over 40 children received 24 hour care, 7 days a week. When I arrived, a young couple just arrived with their 3 year old girl.

Vietnam

We visited two these orphanages in November on a full day trip into the tropical rainforests of this beautiful country.

Center of Hope #1 is a smaller orphanage with 15 children. We had a great visit, interacting with the children and directors. We brought shoes and groceries for the home. They were so grateful. The children entertained us in song! We support this home on a monthly basis.

Center of Hope #2 is a very large orphanage with over 100 children. Ages 1-12. This is a very vibrant home. All the children were abandoned. Their "short life" stories are so heart rendering. The children performed for us in song and memorization. They were in need of shoes so we brought shoes, food, and candy treats. It was like Christmas came early! We observed the desperate need for showers and bathrooms for the children. After receiving a proposal for the construction costs, we decided this was a matter of urgency and IHHS stepped up to the need. We raised \$10,000 for this project which will be completed by the end of March. Thank you to all who generously gave to this project.

In 2017 we partnered with Another Journey, an NGO in Arizona. Alisa Cool, one of our directors began a non profit organization which provides tax receipts for donations received in the USA. Through Another Journey people from the USA can donate to IHHS projects and receive a tax receipt. This also works in the reverse. If you live in CANADA and wish to give a donation to Another Journey, you can get tax receipts from IHHS for funds designated to Another Journey. This opens a lot of doors for both organizations who partner in projects.

At the end of February we leave for Nairobi again...anticipating advancements and new projections. In Fall 2018 we plan to visit Cebu, Sanya, Cambodia and Vietnam. In the future we will take a group of volunteers to the baby orphanage in Shanghai!

Thank you for believing in the work we are doing. Many lives are being changed....receiving education, loving care and a hope for their future.
